SEWING SUPPLIES

Sewing machine with quarter inch foot

Needles for your sewing machine

Neutral colored thread for top and bobbin

Rotary Cutter and small rotary cutting ruler

Scissors

Seam Ripper

Pins

FABRIC SUPPLIES

Black Solid (used for border and blocks) 1 ½ yards

Gray Solid (used for blocks and sashing) ¾ yard

*Assorted solid colors (6-7) from same color family 1/8 yard of each

*Contrasting color for corner stones 1/8 yard

A note regarding fabric choices:

Blocks: Amish quilts traditionally go with a color family and use various shades/values of those fabrics. So in deciding on a color scheme for your quilt you could choose blues, or purples, or browns. Once you have decided on your color – then choose 6-7 shades of that color ranging from light to dark.

Cornerstones: The conerstones in the quilt give that little bit of pop of color. So pick something that contrasts with the colors you have picked for the blocks
