

## Fat Quarter Friendly Reversible Tote



### Supply List:

6 Fat Quarters

1 FQ for outside sides

1 FQ for outside center

2 FQ for lining- can be same fabric or 2 different fabrics

2 FQ for outside pocket- should be 2 different fabrics

Straps can be either colored webbing or made from leftover pieces of your FQ's with fusible fleece inside.

1/2 yard Fusible Fleece (18" x 42")

Coordinated Thread

1/2 yard Fusible light-medium interfacing (optional-for lining)

2 Decorative buttons for the outside pockets

Yardage can also be used. I liked longer straps and all the same fabric for my lining so yardage worked well for me.

Prior to class, cut a piece of fabric to be used for the sides of your tote to approximately 18-19" x 20".

Cut the same size for the fabric you will be using for the outside center of your bag.

Fuse fusible fleece on the backs of both of these. We will trim further in class.

If you will be opting to use fusible interfacing on your lining, follow the same instructions as above using your lining fabric and interfacing.
