Introduction

Olé! Spinning around and around this unusual star will amaze you with its simple construction; making spikey stars has never been so easy! By using the Split Rects and Corner Pop together you get a unique combination of sharp points that are perfect every time. This project is perfect for the stack of 10" squares awaiting its day to shine.



Quilt can be made in Lap 57" x 71", Twin 71" x 85" or Queen 85" x 99".

Fabrics Needed

Fabric	Lap	Twin	Queen
Brights	36 – 10" squares	64 - 10" squares	100 – 10" squares
Background	4-1/4 yards	6 yards	8 yards
Binding	1/2 yard	5/8 yard	3/4 yard
Backing	4-1/2 yards	5-1/4 yards	8-3/4 yards

Supplies

- Studio 180 Design Fiesta pattern
- Studio 180 Design Split Rects Tool
- Studio 180 Corner Pop Tool
- Rotary Cutter, 6" x 12" ruler or larger, Marking Pencil
- Sewing machine in good working order, bobbins, thread
- Pins, seam ripper and other general sewing supplies

Pre-Class Preparation

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabric	Unit	Lap	Twin	Queen
Brights	Half Rectangle	From each 10" square cut a 6" strip for a total of 36 - 6" x 10" strips	From each 10" square cut a 6" strip for a total of 64 - 6" x 10" strips	From each 10" square cut a 6" strip for a total of 100 - 6" x 10" strips
	Diamond Border	From the remainder of the 10" squares, cut 60 3" x 3" squares	From the remainder of the 10" squares, cut 76 3" x 3" squares	From the remainder of the 10" squares, cut 92 3" x 3" squares
Background	Half Rectangle	Cut 8 strips 6" x WOF	Cut 13 strips 6" x WOF	Cut 20 strips 6" x WOF
	Replacement Triangles	Cut 4 strips 3-3/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 36 squares 3-3/4" x 3-3/4", then cut once diagonally to yield 72 triangles.	Cut 7 strips 3-3/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 64 squares 3-3/4" x 3-3/4", then cut once diagonally to yield 128 triangles.	Cut 10 strips 3-3/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 100 squares 3-3/4" x 3-3/4", then cut once diagonally to yield 200 triangles.
	Diamond Border Setting Triangles	Cut 4 strips 5-1/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 32 squares 5-1/4" x 5-1/4", then cut twice diagonally to yield 128 triangles.	Cut 6 strips 5-1/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 40 squares 5-1/4" x 5-1/4", then cut twice diagonally to yield 160 triangles.	Cut 7 strips 5-1/4" x WOF Sub-cut into 48 squares 5-1/4" x 5-1/4", then cut twice diagonally to yield 192 triangles.
	Side and Corner Setting Triangles	Cut 3 strips 8" x WOF	Cut 4 strips 8" x WOF	Cut 5 strips 8" x WOF
	* Outer Border	Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 57" Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 64"	Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 71-1/4" Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 78-1/2"	Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 85-1/2" Cut/piece 2 strips 4" x 92-1/2"

DO NOT CUT OUTER BORDER STRIPS UNTIL YOUR QUILT IS MADE TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE CUTTING THEM TO YOUR OWN PERSONAL MEASUREMENTS!!!
