

# Finley's Fence Quilt

## Introduction

Finley's Fence features playful rings of interwoven colors, made up of fat quarters, to create this modern play on an Irish Links quilt. This whimsical quilt comes together easily with the help of the Tucker Trimmer 1 and with Michelle's inventive use of the Corner Pop tool the otherwise difficult angled/bias unit becomes tons of fun to make.



Can be made in three sizes: Baby (54" x 54"), Throw (66" x 78"), and Twin (78" x 102")

## Fabrics Needed

Fabric	Baby	Twin	Queen
Background (White)	2-2/3 yards OR 3 yards*	4-2/3 yards OR 5 yards*	6 yards OR 6-1/2 yards*
Assorted Brights	2-1/4 yards OR 10 Fat Quarters	4-1/4 yards OR 20 Fat Quarters	7 yards OR 33 Fat Quarters
Binding	1/2 yard	2/3 yard	3/4 yard
Backing	3-1/2 yards	5 yards	7 yards

\* **Background if using lengthwise border**

## Supplies

- Finleys Fence pattern by Studio 180 Design
- Tucker Trimmer I™ Tool by Studio 180 Design
- Corner Pop Tool™ by Studio 180 Design
- InvisiGRIP is highly recommended for the back of your tool
- Rotary Cutter, 6" x 12" ruler or larger
- Sewing machine in good working order, bobbins, thread
- Pins, seam ripper and other general sewing supplies

	5-1/4" Squares*, cut diagonally into half square triangles (HST)	Background	Cut 7 strips 5-1/4" x WOF.  Sub-cut into 44 5-1/4" squares.  Cut each square into once diagonally 88 HST.	Cut 14 strips 5-1/4" x WOF.  Sub-cut into 98 5-1/4" squares.  Cut each square into once diagonally 196 HST.	Cut 22 strips 5-1/4" x WOF.  Sub-cut into 148 5-1/4" squares.  Cut each square into once diagonally 296 HST.
	* NOTE: If you want lengthwise borders, cut them <b>BEFORE</b> cutting the 5-1/4" squares. If you do lengthwise borders you will need to cut extra strips to cut all of the squares required.

### Pre-Cutting Instructions if using **Fat Quarters**:

Unit	Piece	Fabric	Baby	Throw	Twin
Flip Units	Rectangles	Assorted Brights	From each fat quarter cut: 3 strips 4-1/2" x WOF strips Sub-cut <b>each</b> color into 9 rectangles 4-1/2" x 6-1/2". <i>Note: This will give you a few extra.</i>		
	5-1/4" Squares, cut diagonally into half square triangles (HST)	Background	Cut 7 strips 5-1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut into 44 5-1/4" squares. Cut each square into once diagonally 88 HST.	Cut 14 strips 5-1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut into 98 5-1/4" squares. Cut each square into once diagonally 196 HST.	Cut 22 strips 5-1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut into 148 5-1/4" squares. Cut each square into once diagonally 296 HST.
	NOTE: If you want lengthwise borders, cut them <b>BEFORE</b> cutting the 5-1/4" squares. If you do lengthwise borders you will need to cut extra strips to cut all of the squares required.
