

Lemoyne Trails

Introduction

Lemoyne Trails is an excellent stash-buster of a project. Simply choose 10-12 fat quarters, two contrasting colors for your background, and a border fabric then you'll be ready to get started on your very own Lemoyne Trail quilt project. The quilt finishes 45" x 57". There are alternate size options, see the last page for yardage and cutting instructions.



Fabrics Needed

A note about fabric selection: Choose at least 6 different fabrics for your Assorted Colors. To make a “scrappier” look, choose more assorted colors. Also, since there is high contrast in the background and Accent fabric, make sure the assorted colors you choose contrasts well with BOTH the background and Accent fabrics.

Background (White)	1-5/8 yards
Assorted Colors	10-12 Fat Quarters OR Scraps to equal approximately 2 yards. For a scrappier look just use more scraps.
Accent (Very Dark)	1-1/8 yards
Inner Border	1/4 yard
Outer Border	3/4 yard

Supplies

- Lemoyne Trails pattern by Studio 180 Design
- Large Square Squared Tool by Studio 180 Design
- Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Tool, by Studio 180 Design
- Tucker Trimmer I or III Tool, by Studio 180 Design
- InvisiGRIP is highly recommended for the back of your tool
- Rotary Cutter, 6" x 12" ruler or larger
- Sewing machine in good working order, bobbins, thread
- Pins, seam ripper and other general sewing supplies

Pre-Class Preparation - Cutting Instructions for 6" Blocks

Please label each cut and keep in a small baggie for easy identification in class.

BACKGROUND FABRIC:

Where Used	What to cut
Hidden Border - half squares	Cut (10) 4" squares
Hidden Border - squares	Cut (16) 3-1/2" squares
Hidden Border - strips	Cut (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
Hidden Border - strips	Cut (2) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles
Hourglass Units	Cut (9) 3" squares
Round 1 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 2-1/2" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Round 2 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 2-3/4" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Round 3 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 3-1/2" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Round 4 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 4-1/4" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Star Background	Cut (7) 3-1/4" x WOF strips, then cut apart to make (14) 3-1/4" x 22" strips

Assorted Color Fabrics:

Where Used	What to cut
Star Points	Cut (28) 2" x 22" strips
Round 1 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 2-1/2" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Round 2 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 2-3/4" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Round 3 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 3-1/2" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Hourglass Units	Cut (9) 3" squares

Accent (Very Dark) Fabric:

Where Used	What to cut
Hidden Border - half squares	Cut (10) 4" squares
Round 4 Snails Trail	Cut (18) 4-1/2" squares, then sub-cut diagonally once
Star Background	Cut (7) 3-1/4" x WOF strips, then cut apart to make (14) 3-1/4" x 22" strips

ALTERNATE SIZE OPTIONS

While the chart below does not include all of the trimming instructions for the different sizes of stacked squares, it does include the fabric amounts and pre-cutting instructions for making not only 6" but also 8" or 12" blocks. Refer to Deb Tucker's Stacked Squares Technique Sheet from Studio 180 Design as well as the Stacked Squares video available on www.studio180design.net for more details about trimming various sizes of Snails Trails (Stacked Squares with strategic placement of dark and light fabrics). Adjust the Quilt Assembly setting piece sizes (shown for the 6" blocks on page 6) as needed. The Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star® tool is designed to make multiple sizes as well. Your Star sizes should match the Snails Trail sizes. Consult the Instruction Sheet packaged with your Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star® tool for more information on making 8" or 12" Lemoyne Stars.

Add Borders as desired to compliment the larger blocks.

**NOTE: Using whole strips instead of half-strips for the 12" stars is a more efficient use of fabric.
