## Introduction

Made with bold and intricate geometrics, just like you'd expect to see in the Moroccan city of Marrakesh, you'll use the Tucker Trimmer and Wing Clipper 1 tools to make this elegant quilt.



Finished Quilt Size 82" x 97"

## Fabrics Needed

Fabric	Yardage
Cream	2-1/2 yards
Blue	3 yards
Focus	1-5/8 yards
Black	3-1/3 yards
Outer Border/Binding (Focus)	2-5/8 yards
Backing/Batting	8-3/4 yards

## Supplies

Studio 180 Design Wing Clipper® tool*	Invisigrip recommended for back of tool
Studio 180 Design Marrakesh pattern*	Fabric pre-cut for class & pre-sewing complete <b>prior to class</b>
Studio 180 Design Tucker Trimmer I® tool*	6" x 12" and/or 6" x 24" Ruler
	Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter
General sewing kit – scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, marking pencil, Best Press (optional) etc.

## Unit Summary

**Shaded 4 Patch** - 5" finished/5½" cut size

*Cream, black, and blue fabrics*

Make 80



**Half Square Triangles** - 2½" finished/3" cut size

*Black, and blue fabrics*

Make 8



**Diamond Squares\*** - 6" finished/6 ½" unfinished

*Black and blue fabrics (Outer Border Corners)-*

Make 4



**Folded Corner Square\*** - 5" finished/5½" cut size

*Black and blue fabrics (Inner Border Corners)*

Make 4



**Flying Geese** - 2½" x 5" finished/3" x 5½" cut size

*Black and Cream fabrics (For Blocks)*

Make 80 (20 sets with 1 large black square and 4 small cream squares)



*Cream and focus fabrics (For Blocks)*

Make 80 (20 sets with 1 large cream square and 4 small focus squares)



*Blue and black fabrics (For Borders)*

Make 104 (26 sets with 1 large blue square and 4 small black squares)



## Pre-Class Preparation

We will construct one complete block during the class.

Note: Strips are full width of fabric (wof)

<b>Shaded 4 Patches</b> 5" finished	Narrow Strip 3 ¼" wide	Cream	Cut 7 strips 3 ¼" wide
	Wide Strip 4 ¼" wide	Black	Cut 7 strips 4 ¼" wide
	Rectangles 6" x 7"	Blue	Cut 7 strips 7" wide, sub-cut into 40 rectangles
<b>Flying Geese</b> 2 ½" x 5" finished	Large Squares 6 ½" x 6 ½"	Black	Cut 4 strips 6 ½" wide, sub-cut 20 squares
		Cream	Cut 4 strips 6 ½" wide, sub-cut 20 squares
		Blue	Cut 5 strips 6 ½" wide, sub-cut 26 squares
	Small Squares 3 ½" x 3 ½"	Cream	Cut 8 strips 3 ½" wide, sub-cut 80 squares
		Focus	Cut 8 strips 3 ½" wide, sub-cut 80 squares
		Black	Cut 10 strips 3 ½" wide, sub-cut 104 squares
<b>Half Square Triangles</b> 2 ½" finished	Squares 3 ½" x 3 ½"	Blue	Cut 1 strip 3 ½" wide, sub-cut 6 squares
		Black	Cut 1 strip 3 ½" wide, sub-cut 6 squares
<b>Center Squares, 5 ½" finished</b>	Squares 5 ½" x 5 ½"	Focus	Cut 3 strips 5 ½" wide, sub-cut 20 squares
<b>Pieced Border Corners</b>	Squares 5 ½" x 5 ½"	Black	Cut 4 Squares
<b>Folded Corner Squares</b>	Squares 3" x 3"	Blue	Cut 4 Squares
<b>Diamond Squares*</b> 6" finished (Outer Border Corners)	Center Squares 6 ½" x 6 ½"	Blue	Cut 1 strip 6 ½" wide Sub-cut into 4 squares
	Corner Triangles	Black	Cut 1 strip 3 ½" Sub-cut into 16 3 ½" squares
<b>Outer Border</b>	Strips	Focus	2 strips 6 ½" x 58 ½" 2 strips 6 ½" x 73 ½"

## Pre Sewing/Marking Prior to Class:

1. **Shaded Four-Patch Units** - sew together lengthwise each 3-1/4" narrow cream strip and each 4-1/4" wide black strip. Press the seam toward the black strip.
2. **Flying Geese Units** - mark two stitching lines 1/4" on either side of each 3-1/2" square through the center diagonal using your Studio 180 Design Quilter's Magic Wand.
