Template Sampler Set (we will not be using all the templates but they are not sold individually so bring the set)

12" Arc

Cross Hair Ruler-8 point or Mini Cross Hair Rulers (3pack)

Marking Implements: Chaco Liner for marking or Erasable FELT tipped markers Chalk pencil (to show up on quilt sandwiches)

Sample Quilt Sandwiches: approximately 10-14" Squares of backing, batting & top fabric Approx 2-3 for practice.

New needle for sewing machine, 80/12 or 90/14 (I use the latter)

Thread-good quality, 50 or 40 weight for top and bobbin. (fill a few bobbins ahead of time) Scissors

Cut for finished wall hanging with a square in a square design:

- 1. Center Fabric (batik or color to showcase the quilt design) Cut 13" Square.
- 2. Outer Fabric for Sq in Sq & Binding:
 - a. Cut Square 17.5"
 - b. Cut above square on diagonal and again on diagonal(forms an X)
 - c. Sew 2 opposite sides of triangle to center square.
 - d. Sew other 2 triangles to the other sides of center square.
- 3. Cut binding (3 strips @ 2.5") and sew together to form binding.
- 4. Cut backing and batting to the size of Square on Square
