Brother has unveiled the new top of the line sewing, quilting and embroidery machine with the most advanced technology available today.

Feature list includes:

Over **10" Large Capacitive Touch Screen** works like a tablet or phone with scrolling features, color navigation, two finger pinch zoom (up to 800%) and sliding.

StitchVision projects sewing stitches on the fabric, you can scan through designs using the special stylus right on the fabric! You can also change the width or length of the stitch on the fabric or the screen. It also is used to project the embroidery design onto fabric in the hoop for perfect alignment.

Large 10 5/8" x 16" embroidery design size capabilities with an improved frame that has rubber plates on both sides of the inner frame to hold fabric securely, plus a push spring lever for ease in hooping!

Strips are sewn onto foundation paper to complete what we call a 'Strip Set'. After the strip sets are completed, they are cut apart, rearranged and resewn into a diamond star point. Either the wall or queen can be made.

Solar Flares was designed by Quiltworx in 2015 as an addition to our collection of patterns that use the (48) pack of 2-1/2" strips that Quiltworx has created, involving pre-sorting and pre-packaging strips in six groups of 8, ranging from light to dark in color value. The design utilizes a block that is familiar to Quiltworx fans, originally used in the Raindrops pattern. The instructions have been adapted for a scrappy layout using 2-1/2" strips and a collection of (36) background fabrics (the pattern requires 1/4 Yard of each!). Foundation paper piecing, floating points, and Template Layout Sheets are featured in these instructions, as they have become design standards that our customers have come to expect when they work with one of our patterns.

Class Policy

Class fees are due at time of registration and do not include materials.

* A machine is required for all classes unless otherwise stated.

* Students receive a 10% discount on all class supplies purchased at the store for our classes.

* Class registration for **Staff classes** can be made over the phone, in person or by mail; and class fees can be paid by cash, check, Synchrony card, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, American Express or debit card.

* Class registration for **Independent instructors** should be made payable to the instructor and the class fees must be paid by check or cash only.

* Teachers may cancel a class due to low registrations, so you are urged to register as soon as possible.

* Class registration must be made at least one week prior to class.

Supply lists can be printed directly from our website or you may pick one up at the store.

Experience levels for the classes:

Level 1 = All Levels (no prior quilting experience necessary)

Level 2 = Basic quilting knowledge (understands rotary cutting, 1/4" seam, made at least one quilt)

Level 3 = Made 1-2 quilts, looking for a challenge

Level 4 = Intermediate/Advanced
