Introduction

We will learn 2 of the 4 new techniques using the Studio 180 Design Star 60 Tool. This class will focus on the Capped 60 and the Framed 60 techniques.

NOTE: You must have taken a class using the Star 60 ruler before taking this class.

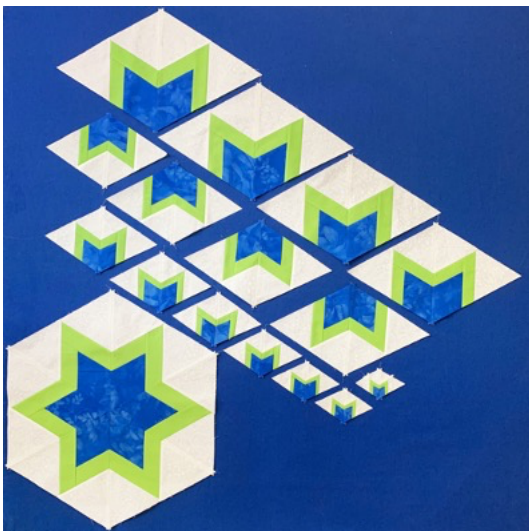
Capped 60

We love using this simple unit to add additional interest to Star 60 designs. This is a great, easy to construct, basic unit that we are using more and more as we continue to work with the Star 60® tool. The unit you make with this technique sheet is sized the same way as the Star 60 unit, so if you want your Capped 60 unit to match up with a 5" Star 60 unit, you'd make a 5" Capped 60 unit.



Framed 60

If you love jazzing up your stars as much as we do, this is one that you're not going to want to skip! The Framed 60 Technique Sheet allows you to create a Star 60 unit with a contrasting band of color added around the outside edge of the diamond. Sew six together and you will get a beautiful framed star, but you can also use them in conjunction with other 60° units to create really interesting looks.

In this class you will be making one of each type of block, therefore fabric requirements are for one block only. Please bring any leftover fabric you have, so that if time permits you can make additional blocks. I suggest you use scrap fabric for this class, and save your good fabric for a later project.

Fabrics Needed

Capped 60

We will be making a 6" finished unit. You will need to cut the following:

For the Trapezoid: Cut 1 strip 3-3/4" x WOF

For the Triangle: Cut 1 strip 3-3/4" x WOF

(NOTE: the strips should be from different fabrics.)

Framed 60

We will be making a 6" finished unit. You will need to cut the following:

Framing Strip: Cut 1 strip 1-3/4" x WOF

Diamond Strip: Cut 1 strip 2-3/4" x WOF

Side Triangle Strip: Cut 1 strip 4" x WOF

(NOTE: the strips should be from different fabrics.)

- Studio 180 Design Star 60© Tool available at Jackie Lynn's
- Invisigrip for the back of the Tool available at Jackie Lynn's
- Rotary Cutter, Cutting Mat, 6" x 12" ruler or larger, Mechanical Pencil fine point
- Sewing machine in good working order, bobbins, thread
- Pins, seam ripper and other general sewing supplies
