Ruler Work Design Lab: Borders and Sashings

Learn how to create unique borders and sashing designs for your quilts. This is a drawing and design class - instead of sewing we will be drawing. Using the rulers that you already have you will explore ways to create unique border and sashing designs. Topics covered included: making the designs fit the space, working around corners, and dividing larger border and sashing spaces .

SUPPLIES

Mechanical drawing pencils or pencils and a pencil shapener

Eraser

Pad of Graph Paper (11 x 17)

Ruler (at least 12" long)

Westalee Design Stitching Line Discs (WA-SLD) - These acrylic disks have a hole in the center to allow you to place a pencil or marking pen in the center. This will ensure that the designs you draw using your templates will be accurate in replicating the size of the design when it is stitched out using a ruler foot on a domestic sewing machine.

Feel free to bring along any sewn tops/projects that you are wanting to quilt with rulers in which you would like to work out some border and sashing designs.

WESTALEE DESIGN RULER REQUIREMENTS

REQUIRED

Bring the 12" Arc from the starter set and the rulers from the Westalee Design Sampler Set

RECOMMENDED

Bring any other Westalee Design rulers that you might have (Clamshell Rulers, Circles, Ovals)-

Bring any other Westalee Design Border Templates or Border Tools. (Continuous Border Templates, Border Tools, Continuous Rope and Echo)
