Triangle Pizazz Technique Sheet Required

The Triangle Pizazz unit is a variation of the Shaded 4 Patch. It can be constructed as identical units to make pinwheels and bow ties, or as mirror image units to create star points as well as other unique creations. As always, the unit will be made oversized then trimmed down to reveal a perfectly sized unit with perfectly matched points. Best of all, it was made without cutting or piecing a single triangle. Includes 21 different Triangle Pizazz unit sizes.

This class will give you the basic technique to create the triangle unit that is used for Triangle Galore Quilt Pattern that is going to be offered in June. This quilt is a stunning array of color and motion that will go together easily. Once you are familiar with the fundamentals you will be ready to make your quilt.

Pre-Class Cutting instructions:

Triangle Pizazz – 8"

Choose 1 light fabric, 1 dark fabric, and a background fabric.

From Background Fabric cut 2 rectangles 4 3/4" x 10"

From Light Fabric cut 2 squares 4 3/4"

From Dark Fabric cut 1 rectangle 9" x 10"

Supply List

Triangle Pizzazz technique sheet

Tucker Trimmer 3 Tool and instructions

Rotary cutter and acrylic ruler

Fabric marking pencil

Fabric Scissors

Straight Pins

Neutral piecing thread

1/4" foot for your machine

Bring your sewing machine with power cord and accessories.

Note: All technique sheet classes will be done with an 8" block. Once you have completed several blocks you will have your own "sampler" quilt.
