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## **Triangles Galore**

This pattern uses the Triangle Pizazz technique to create a quilt full of spinning triangles in four different sizes - and its fat quarter friendly! Give this quilt a scrappy look by using many bright fat quarters or pick your favorite coordinating colors for a more subtle appearance. Whichever direction you select, you are bound to end up with a sensational quilt!

Four project sizes: Crib (34"x 50"), Lap (54"x 68"), Twin (68"x 97"), and Full (82"x 97") Required tools: <u>Tucker Trimmer III</u>



## **Cutting Instructions**
