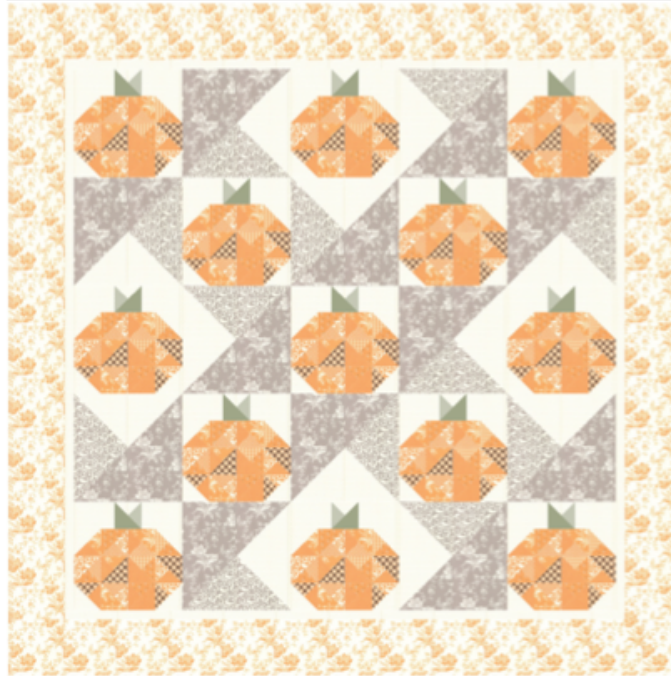


## Turning Up Pumpkins Quilt

### Introduction

Turning Up Pumpkins is a fantastic STASHBuster Quilt that comes together simply and creates a beautiful seasonal quilt. Turning Up Pumpkins features a Pumpkin Block and Setting Block. Rotating of the Setting Block allows for multiple designs. This is the perfect design to use up similar in color Fat Quarters to make up your Pumpkins (or even Apples). While this quilt is designed to utilize your stash, do not ever be afraid to purchase some, if not all new fabric.

### Fabrics Needed

PLACEMENT	FABRIC	YARDAGE
Pumpkins	Orange	10 Fat Quarters
Pumpkin Stems	Green	2 Fat Quarters (1 Light and 1 Medium)
Setting Block	Medium Gray	1 Yard*
Setting Block	Light Gray	½ Yard
Quilt Center and Inner Border	Background	2 Yards*
Border & Binding	Print/Floral	2 ¼ Yards
Backing		4 ½ Yards

**Note: \*If your selected Fabric has less than 40" usable inches, you will need to go add an extra ¼ yard to the amount.**

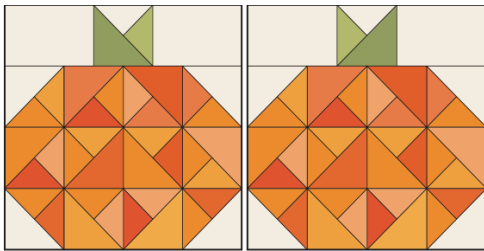

## Supplies

- Turning Up Pumpkins pattern by Sew on the Go, available for purchase at Jackie Lynn's
- Studio 180 Design Tucker Trimmer III available for purchase at Jackie Lynn's
- Invisigrip for the back of the Tucker Trimmer III available for purchase at Jackie Lynn's
- Studio 180 Design Quilters Magic Wand available for purchase at Jackie Lynn's
- Rotary Cutter, Cutting Mat, 6" x 12" ruler or larger, Mechanical Pencil fine point
- Sewing machine in good working order, bobbins, thread
- Pins, seam ripper and other general sewing supplies

## BLOCK OVERVIEW

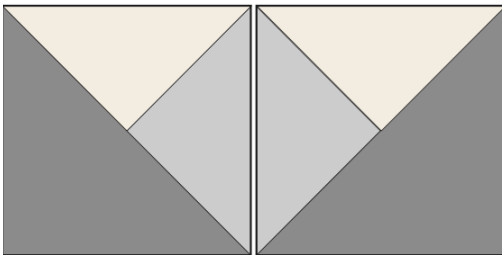
### Pumpkin



Make (13) Total Finish as 12" x 12" (Cut: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2")

Note: Because the nature of the unit, half of blocks will have your "Stems" be the mirror images of the other blocks "Stems". The Quilt design takes this into account.

### Setting Block



Make (12) Total Finish as 12" x 12" (Cut: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2")

Note: Because of the nature of the unit, half of your blocks will be mirror images of each other. The Quilt design takes this into account and depends on half of the block being one way and half of the Blocks being the other way.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS - FOR BLOCKS AND QUILT BORDERS

WOF = Width of Fabric, cut from selvage to selvage, typically 40" - 42" in length.

HWOFF = Half Width of Fabric, the width of a Fat Quarter or when you cut a WOF in half, creating (2) Strips typically 20"-21" in length.

QST = Quarter Square Triangle





HST = Half Square Triangle

Cutting instructions and directions are for the complete quilt. They will produce: (13) Pumpkin Blocks, (12) Setting Blocks, and the Inner and Outer Borders.


**Note: For this pattern, you will need a total of (130) 4 ½" Squares of Orange Fabric.**

My suggestion is that you cut (13) 4 ½" Squares from all (10) Fat Quarters. Then divide up the Orange Squares and assign them to the unit/placements below; Background Combo QST, Orange Combo QST or Orange Combo HST (Orange highlighted below).

**PLEASE KEEP ALL UNIT COMPONENTS TOGETHER IN A BAGGIE OR ON A PAPER PLATE FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION IN CLASS.**

A	Background Combo Units 	52	Quarter Square Triangle (QST)	Assorted Orange Fabric	Cut a total (26) 4 ½" Squares
			Half Square Triangle (HST)	Background	Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF Strips*  Sub cut into (26) 4 ½" Squares
B	Orange Combo Units 	104	Quarter Square Triangle (QST)	Assorted Orange Fabric	Cut a total (52) 4 ½" Squares
			Half Square Triangle (HST)	Assorted Orange Fabric	Cut a total (52) 4 ½" Squares
C	Stem Combo Units 	13**	Background Quarter Square Triangle (QST)	Background	*Utilize the remnant from Background Combo to cut into (4) 4 ½" Squares
			Quarter Square Triangle (QST)	Light Green Fat Quarter	Cut (4) 4 ½" Squares
			Half Square Triangle (HST)	Medium Green Fat Quarter	Cut (7) 4 ½" Squares
D	Background Rectangle 	26	Block Background	Background	Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF Strips  Sub cut (26) 3 ½" x 5" Rectangles

	UNIT	# OF UNITS	PLACEMENT	FABRIC VALUE/COLOR	CUT
E	Setting Block 	12	Background QST	Background	Cut (1) 13 1/2" x WOF Strips Sub cut into (3) 13 1/2" Squares
			Light Gray QST	Light Gray	Cut (1) 13 1/2" x WOF Strips Sub cut into (3) 13 1/2" Squares
			Dark Gray HST	Medium Gray	Cut (2) 13 1/2" x WOF Strips Sub cut into (6) 13 1/2" Squares

*\*\*Due to the nature of the construction of this block, there will be an extra Block made.*

Class 1: We will make the Pumpkin and Setting Blocks.

Class 2: We will work on the quilt top construction.

NOTE: We will not be cutting the Inner and Outer border until your quilt top is assembled. Remember, the border measurements supplied in the pattern are estimates. You should measure your quilt in three places in each direction, then average those to determine your border length. This will ensure that your borders fit your quilt top and are not pinched or wavy.
