

Wedding Star Table Topper

Pre-cutting the papers is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this course. Please begin preparing for class at least 1-WEEK prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get the pre-cutting completed before hand. This process will take you from 1- to 3-hours to complete, which does not count the time spent at the fabric store selecting the fabrics to use in the quilt. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction. I do not want anyone to feel as though they have wasted their money and time.

Wedding Star Table Topper Class: In this class, you will learn the techniques necessary to complete the Wedding Star Table Topper pattern. Please read through the instructions in BOTH booklets. Yardage requirements are listed on the back of Booklet #2.

Cutting and Organization: In preparation for class, you will need:

- 1) All of your papers cut and placed into the appropriate bags. Instructions for this are included Booklet #2 on page 1 under the heading *Bags*.
- 2) All of your 2-1/2 inch strips cut. If you are cutting your own, you will need to cut 16 strips from a variety of light, medium, and dark fabrics on your own.
- 3) All of your Template Layout Sheets and associated fabric cutting completed (including the Backgrounds and Star Templates) and placed into the appropriate bags. Follow the instructions beginning with Booklet 2 Page 8- Page 10.

The following items will be used in class:

Sewing Machine with a quarter-inch foot and Accessories
Steam Iron
Ironing Board
Template Plastic
12" Add-a-quarter ruler
Purple Thang
6" by 12" ruler
Medium size cutting mat (18" by 24")
Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm (I also like a 28mm)
New rotary blade
Size 70 needles (Microtex recommended)
Scissors
Seam ripper
Surge protectors
Extension cords
Fabric glue UHU stic
Glue Pen (Fons and Porter, Sewline, or Avery recommended)
High quality cotton sewing thread
Flower pins
Scotch Tape
Large Ziploc Bags
Binder Clips or Large Paper Clips
