

Discount Sewing Center & Jackie Lynn's Fabrics

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Luminaire Club – In the Hoop Quilt As You Go

This will be a two-month project. We will create a quilt comprised of 10" squares that are embroidered and quilted in the hoop. We will program one or two blocks in class and sew out the first one on club day.

Machine features covered:

Laser Sewing Grid & Sizing features
Automatic Stipple/Echo Quilting around a design
Hoop selection for quilting
Border/Sash Quilting and computation
Image Projection to align your design with your fabric
Thread tension adjustment
Design element color changes
Using the built-in memory to build our blocks



*Supply List for a 9-block quilt/wall hanging:

1/2 yard cotton fabric for background

Cut (9) 6 1/2" squares

3/4 yard each of (3) coordinating frame colors

From each color cut (3) 2 1/2" strips (WOF)

From each color cut (1) 14" strip, re-cut into (3) 14" squares (for back of each square)

1 yard batting

Cut (9) pieces big enough to cover the largest XP1 hoop

7 yards Soft & Sheer lightweight cutaway stabilizer

505 Temporary spray adhesive

Rotary cutter and acrylic ruler

Empty bobbins

Pins and scissors

Assorted embroidery threads

*Since these blocks are pieced together after the embroidery and quilting is complete, you can make this quilt as big as you like. Or simply make a runner! Purchase fabric accordingly.

Bring your machine with your largest hoop, accessories and power cord if you wish to work on the project in class.

Handouts will be available and the store machine will be used as demonstration for those who prefer to leave their machine at home.
